## EX-GRATIA GRANT TO WAR-WIDOWS/NoK AND TO DISABLED SOLDIERS

1. During declared war/insurgency operations, Defence officers/soldiers who had laid down their lives or who are disabled during such war/insurgency operation which are strictly due to war/war like situations, the State Government whose domiciled the bereaved/disabled officer/soldier is, pays ex-gratia grant to war widow/Next-of-Kin and disabled soldiers. The data available of such ex-gratia grant is given on the succeeding pages.
2. The States which are not extending this concession are requested to do so as this will provide financial support to the war-widows/NoK and disabled soldiers.
